

#### Central Interceptor goes underground

Parts of Auckland's \$1.2 billion Central Interceptor wastewater project have been declared mine sites as some areas start to go underground in preparation for tunnelling operations.

The 14.7 kilometre, 4.5 metre diameter tunnel will run underground at depths ranging from 22 metres to 110 metres, the project spanning Western Springs to the new pump station at the Mängere Wastewater Treatment Plant. It crosses the Manukau Harbour about 15 metres below the seabed.
